Use an A4 size pastel sheet. (1.1.9)

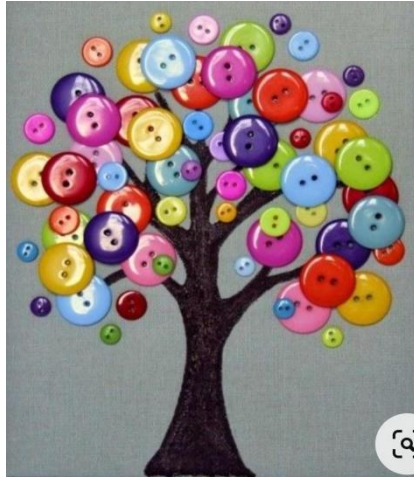
